The format will be a two part, three hour interactive workshop in which Ms. Hicks will cover subjects from employers required legal posting, documentations, the do's and don'ts of interviewing and hiring, harassment and discrimination laws, and leaves of absence in the state of California. Ms. Hicks will also cover the current wage and hour issues that can potentially get employers into trouble.
